In last month's newsletter, I informed you that Little Kitchen HTX was selected as the city's concessionaire for the new clubhouse at Jersey Meadow Golf Club. While we await the grand opening in several months, we're looking for ideas on what to name the restaurant. Visit jerseyvillagetx.com to submit your ideas!

During our January regular meeting, the city council approved the creation of a bond committee to identify parks projects for inclusion in a bond proposal that will be placed on the November ballot. The city is currently accepting applications for this committee, and I want to encourage anyone with an interest in shaping the future of our parks to apply. Finally, I want to update you on the old Chevron gas station that has languished for years at the corner of Senate Ave. and Highway 290. The city initiated the legal process to declare the building substandard. This would require the owners to either bring the building up to code or demolish it. At a public hearing, a representative for the owner advised city council that they intended to renovate the property and lease it out as retail space. City council ordered the owner to submit plans for renovation and a permit application within 30 days. Our hope is that we will soon see an end to the visual blight at one of the key entrances to the city. If the company doesn't follow through, we're prepared to take further steps to remedy the situation.

Your city council is committed to ensuring our community remains a beautiful and vibrant place to live. I want to encourage our citizens to use the city's website or our mobile app to report any code issues so the city can address them.
